The colors of street signs aren't just a coincidence. Different colors catch our attention in different ways.		
	Red Urgent message to pay attention to such as STOP and DO NOT ENTER	(Put hash marks in this column)
	Black and white Motorist advisories such as speed limit or one-way streets	
	Yellow Permanent hazard areas such as crosswalks, YIELD , and traffic lights	
	Orange Temporary hazard area, such as road work and construction	
	Blue Less urgent information, such as a hospital, rest stop, or dining	
	Green Travel information such as a street name or freeway exit number
