Hi Parents,

We are pleased to have our first ever Bike Rodeo Scavenger Hunts. We want everyone to be safe, so we ask you to follow these simple rules:

- Make this a family event. If others join you – please practice physical distancing.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- **THE CREEKS AND RIVERS ARE RAGING—DO NOT GO NEAR THE WATER!**
Clues will not be near water.
- **Follow ALL traffic rules:** STOP at Stop signs, ride in bike lanes or on the right side of the road, watch for traffic, etc.
- Please dress appropriately. Bring along rain gear, just in-case.
- Wear sunscreen.
- Stay hydrated and bring water.
- Snacks are recommended. See our snack page for ideas.
- Each Scavenger Hunt has it's own rules. Specific rules will be posted with the Hunt.
- Prizes. We have a limited number of prizes. When you complete your hunt, call the fire station to see if prizes are still available.

Depending on the age of your children and the length of the scavenger hunt – you may want to park a car at the end so that you can load up your bikes and drive home.
